About Us



We are a regional resource center for the public libraries in Calvert, Charles and St. Mary's counties. We provide services to keep communities connected, from materials processing/cataloging and the interlibrary loan system to a host of online resources for information, training and digital materials downloads. We also provide library staff training so they can best meet the community's needs.

Key Initiatives

- SMRLA managed the implementation of **Microsoft 365** as the primary access point for regional library information and collaboration. The new Southern Maryland Integrated Library Exchange, or SMILEportal, is a cloud-based workspace for SMRLA and the three county libraries.  **SMILEportal**

- We conducted a regional **library delivery system study** with Pronevitz Consulting. The project measured our delivery costs, volume, customer satisfaction and overall trends to plot needs for the next five years. As a result, we issued a request for proposals for delivery services to gather potential solutions for our system that ships more than half a million items annually.

- To support regional broadband accessibility, SMRLA administered a  **\$70,000 Maryland Office of Statewide**

Broadband Digital Inclusion Grant.

The funds are being used to finance data plans for library hotspot device lending programs. The portable routers are used by patrons to connect to the internet in areas underserved by broadband.


- As our region grows, in FY23 we **added four new branches or locations** to the regional system: the Charles County Detention Center, Charles County Discovery Lab, Charles County Nanjemoy Kiosk, and the St. Mary's County Mobile Library.

- SMRLA conducted a **Regional Training Needs Assessment** to help guide development of staff training opportunities. In FY23, we used Maryland

State Library Agency grant funds to deliver 344 training recordings and 80 live trainings to library staff statewide. For the Southern Maryland region, we created an in-house training session on our integrated library system, the centralized repository for all of the content our libraries have to offer.

- We also deployed a **Digital Resource Survey** to assess digital resource priorities across the region. The survey helps us maintain a diverse set of online tools for our community. To support our youngest readers, for example, we debuted BookFlix, an ebook library for PreK-3 kids that pairs animated stories with nonfiction ebooks.

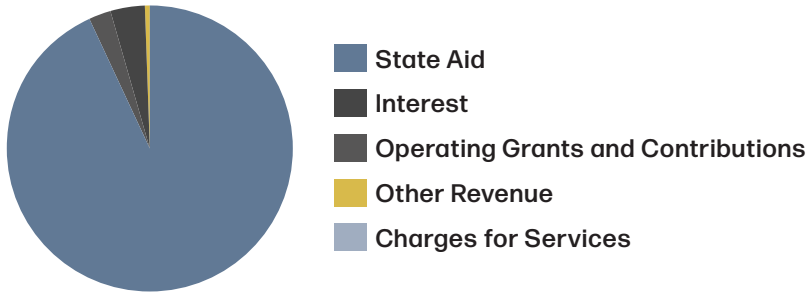

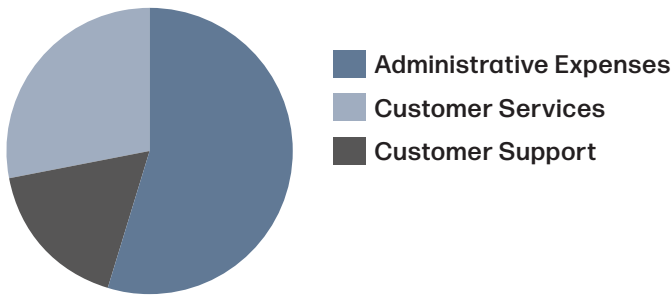

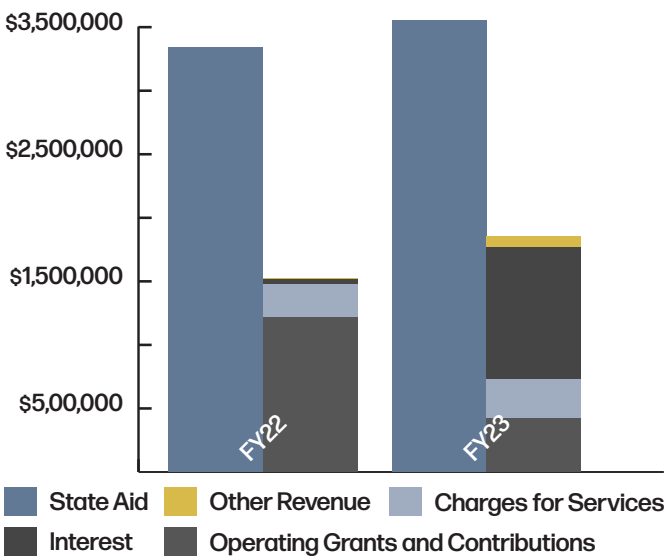

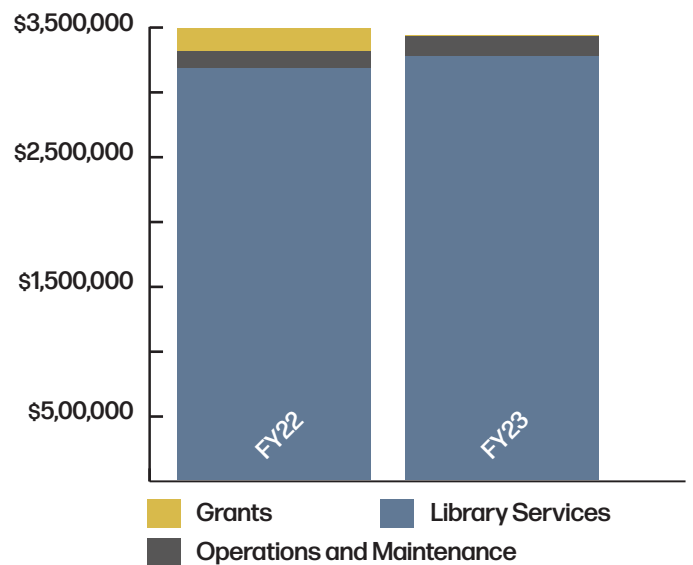
**EXCESS of REVENUES
